Campaigning: We encourage folks to dress up as candidates and walk around campaigning at the event. Team up with another organization to campaign a "common enemy." Each candidate is able to make a 2-minute performance pitch before polls close. This is a great way to educate allies about your organization's campaign. We will also include the brief description of your Scrooge above in the program. Feel free to make signs or any other promotional items for your candidate. Election: Each ticket to the event buys 20 votes that can be cast all for one candidate or divided among many. The purchaser does *not* need to be present to cast the votes. You can still involve members that cannot attend by selling votes, and your organization will cast their votes. **JwJ recommends nominating organizations garner a minimum of 500 votes for your candidate.** This ensures your nominee makes a respectable showing throughout Scrooge campaigning. As we said earlier, additional votes will be sold by those campaigning at the event.

WINNER!: the nominating organization with the "**winning**" candidate can decide what to do with the award. Jobs with Justice may prepare a direct action to deliver the Scrooge, or simply publicize the winner.
