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Five statewide measures on the November 2026 Missouri ballot:

Amendment 3 — Abortion / gender care (legislature-referred). NO

Repeals the 2024 voter-approved Amendment 3 (abortion through viability). Allows abortion only for rape/incest under 12 weeks, medical emergencies, and fetal anomalies; lets the legislature regulate providers; requires parental consent for minors; bans gender transition procedures for minors. Yes = repeal 2024 rights. No = keep them.

Amendment 6 — Initiative petition protection (citizen initiative). YES

Makes the initiative/referendum a fundamental right. Legislature couldn't amend or repeal voter-passed laws (or re-pass referendum-rejected ones) without 80% of both chambers. Keeps current signature thresholds and simple-majority passage. Courts could revise ballot summaries. Yes = lock in voter-passed laws. No = status quo.

Amendment 7 — "Show-Me Prosperity Fund" (legislature-referred). NO

Creates a permanent state endowment intended to eventually replace state taxes. Legislature can't touch the fund until the Treasurer certifies earnings are enough to eliminate taxes; withdrawals capped at 3% of five-year average value. Legislature regains taxing power if the fund fails. No immediate tax impact.

Amendment 8 — County sheriffs (legislature-referred). NO

Constitutionalizes what's already statute: elected sheriffs every four years and their duties. Removal only by quo warranto from the Attorney General. Yes = move statute into the Constitution. No = leave it as statute.

Proposition A — Congressional map referendum (citizen referendum). NO

Up-or-down vote on HB 1 from the 2025 special session, the new congressional map. Yes = keep the new map. No = revert to the 2022 boundaries.
